The next line of the Lord's prayer says:

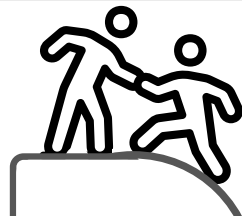
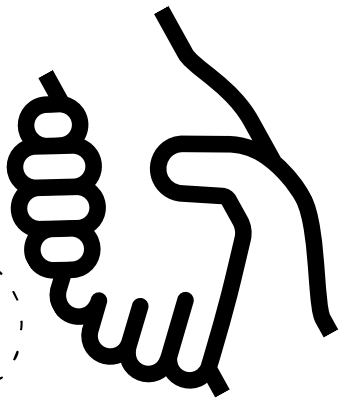
