learn how to pray.

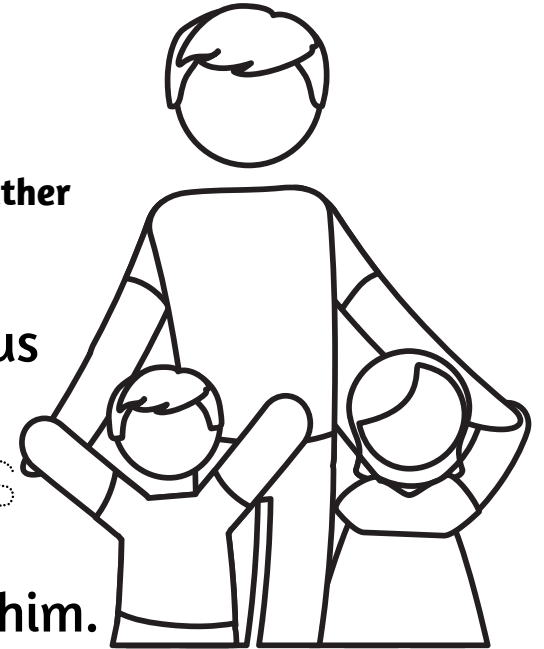
That means talking to God!

# Our Father...

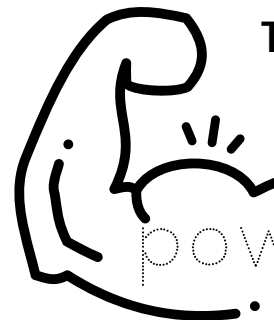
Because Jesus died and rose again to save us, we can be in his family and speak to God **his Father** as **our Father!**

when we talk to him.

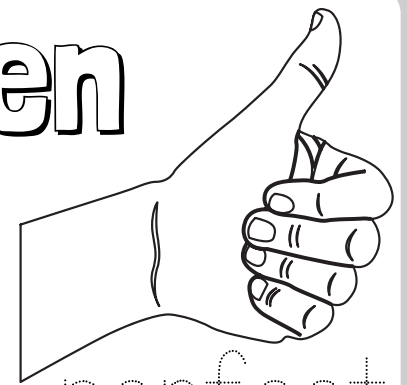

That means God our Father is...

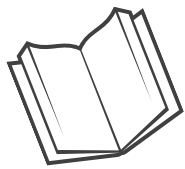
